

Getting Started

To download AprivaPay from the Google Play Store, you'll need to have a Gmail account. If you don't have a Gmail account, you will need to create one before you can begin using AprivaPay.

Follow these steps to create a Gmail account using your Android device:

- 1. Tap your device function button, and then tap Settings.
- 2. Tap Accounts & Sync.
- 3. Tap Add account at the bottom of the screen.
- 4. Tap Google.
- 5. When the Add a Google Account screen appears, tap Next.
- 6. Tap Create.
- 7. Enter your First name, Last name and a username, and then tap Next.
- 8. Your device will communicate with the Google servers and then prompt for you to create a password.
- 9. Create and confirm your password, and then tap Next.
- 10. Choose a Security question and enter the answer to the question, and then enter a Secondary Email. Tap Create to continue.
- 11. At the Google Terms of Service screen, tap I agree, Next.
- 12. Enter the verification code displayed on the screen, and then tap Next.
- 13. Select your prefered sync options, and then tap Finish.
- 13. Tap Finish Setup.

Download AprivaPay for Android from the Play Store

Once your ISO/Reseller approves your application and boards your information on their system, you will receive an e-mail instructing you to download the application from the Android Market.




• Tap Play Store.



• Tap the search icon.




• Enter aprivapay in the search box and then tap the search icon.

• Tap Install.




• Tap Accept & download to begin the download and installation.




Activate AprivaPay

Once the AprivaPay software downloads, you will need to activate the AprivaPay for Android application on your device. Below are the step-by-step instructions for performing the activation:



 Open your app drawer and tap AprivaPay.




• Tap Activate




• Enter the Activation Code you received in your e-mail, and then tap Submit.



• Create a PIN.



• Tap OK.




• Click Agree.

You are now ready to perform live transactions. If you purchased a card reader to use with AprivaPay, please see *Peripheral Configuration* on the next page.




Peripheral Configuration

If you purchased a Magnetic Stripe Reader for use with AprivaPay, you will need to configure it in the AprivaPay application before it can be used.







• Tap the back function on your phone until you are returned to the AprivaPay home screen.



- Enable Card reader, and then Tap No card reader selected.
- Select your card reader under Other devices.

Troubleshooting:

- If you are using a phone cover/protector, remove it, insert the card reader, and then retry your transaction.
- Verify that you have selected the correct card reader under *Settings > Card Reader*.
- Be sure that you turn the volume to it's maximum level after inserting the card reader.
- Try swiping the credit card in the opposite direction.
- At the AprivaPay Credit Sale screen, remove the card reader from your phone and then re-insert it and try your transaction again.
